

Minutes of the Southeast PTA Meeting October 7, 2008

The meeting was called to order at 6:42 p.m. Everyone stood for the Pledge of Allegiance and introductions were made by each of the members. The minutes were read and approved with first and second motions from Ada Crowley and Joanie Quinn respectively. The minutes were accepted. The treasurer's report was distributed and showed a balance brought forward of \$13,131.59. A motion was made to pay Southeast's bills by Julie Keaty and seconded by Lori Kennedy. The motion passed. Ada Crowley thanked everyone who baked for the Room Parent Tea and especially thanked Gina Canon for volunteering to take over the Room Parent Tea next year. Ada also reported on Assemblies. Jane Adams will be November 17th at 10:00 and Ada will be looking into Pioneer Days. Anything for the newsletter is due to Vanessa by October 23rd. Walk to School Day will take place tomorrow, weather permitting – rain date will be Thursday October 9th. Jenny Knight and Peg McKeever received a \$200 donation from Little Company of Mary Hospital as well as a donation from Bleekers. Each child will also receive a granola bar.

Joanie Quinn discussed the Recycle contest that will run from October 15th until November 15th. This will coincide with America's Recycle Day. Bags will be given out to students in the Thursday envelope. The Reflections theme is "Wow" and Kimberly and Barb will be working on it. Ada reminded us that the new flag is flying and looks great. Julie is working on the 50th Anniversary newsletter and the website will be updated in a few days. Thanks Julie. Our next meeting will be on Election Day at 7:00.

Shaton then discussed that there would be Instructional Walkthroughs talking place in the building looking for good teaching. She also reported Miss Brown resigned and welcomed Louise Baldwin in her place. Open House will take place on October 23rd.
