STUDENT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Kindergarten/New Students/Change of Address	Returning Students
<p>Kindergarten students must be 5 years of age on or before September 1, 2011. Student registration, for Kindergarten and students new to District 124 should call the district office to schedule an appointment.</p> <p>Please bring your child’s original birth certificate (with county seal), social security number, and a “student in good standing form” from your child’s previous school along with the documents listed below.</p>	<p>This year we are continuing our residency verification process and fee payment days. For all currently registered students their invoice, emergency form, free lunch application, and waiver of fee form will be available for parents at the door on the registration days.</p> <p>Please bring the acceptable residency verification items that are listed below.</p>

Required Documents for Kindergarten and New Students:

You will need one of the following: current mortgage papers, current homeowner’s insurance policy or apartment lease listing all tenants, receipt from last month’s payment and a certificate of inspection. If your area code does not match the Evergreen Park 708 area code, the phone bill must be provided showing your address. Additionally, residency Illinois photo ID card, and two (2) additional proofs of residency from list below must be presented at registration.

Acceptable Residency Verification for All Students:

One (1) utility, credit card or water bill and one (1) bank statement, mortgage statement, pay check stub (with address), or medicard statement dated the month of July. In addition to the above verification, all renters must also bring in a current lease.

WHEN Important school information (class assignments/schedules etc.) may be picked up in all buildings on Thursday, August 18, 2011 from 11:30-3:30 p.m. and 4:30-6:00 p.m. Your child’s information will not be made available to you without residency confirmation. Parents must attend one of the dates listed below prior to August 18, 2011 to avoid delays on that day.

HEALTH EXAMINATIONS

- Every student must show proof of a health examination and proof of immunizations upon entry into kindergarten or first grade, prior to entrance into pre-school, upon entering sixth grade or upon first entry into any school. Proof must be submitted on or before the first day of student attendance.
- All children enrolling in kindergarten, and any child enrolling in an Illinois school for the first time, are required to have an eye examination before October 15, 2011.
- Students in kindergarten, second, and sixth grade, and any child enrolling in District 124 for the first time, must have a dental exam prior to May 15, 2012.
