

STUDENT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Kindergarten and New Students	Returning Students
<p>Kindergarten students must be 5 years of age on or before September 1, 2010. Student registration, for Kindergarten and students new to District 124, will take place on August 11, 2010 from 1:00-3:30 p.m. or 5:00-7:00 p.m.</p> <p>Please bring your child’s original birth certificate (<u>with county seal</u>), social security number, and a “student in good standing form” from your child’s previous school along with the documents listed below.</p>	<p>This year we are continuing our residency verification process and fee payment days. Registration packets were sent home, with students, to parents/guardians during the week of June 1st. The packets contained a fee statement for each child and an emergency information/residency verification form. The fee statement and emergency information/residency verification form, along with two proofs of residency from the list below, must be presented at registration.</p>

RESIDENCY VERIFICATION INFORMATION

Required Documents for Kindergarten and New Students:

You will need one of the following: current mortgage papers, current homeowner’s insurance policy or apartment lease listing all tenants, receipt from last month’s payment and a certificate of inspection. If your area code does not match the Evergreen Park 708 area code, the phone bill must be provided showing your address. Additionally, residency Illinois photo ID card, and two (2) additional proofs of residency from list below must be presented at registration.

Acceptable Residency Verification for All Students:

One (1) utility, credit card or water bill and one (1) bank statement, mortgage statement, pay check stub (with address), or medicard statement dated the month of July. In addition to the above verification, all renters must also bring in a current lease.

WHEN Important school information (class assignments/schedules etc.) may be picked up in all buildings on Thursday, August 19, 2010 from 11:30-3:30 p.m. and 4:30-6:00 p.m. Your child’s information will not be made available to you without residency confirmation. Parents must attend one of the dates listed below prior to August 19, 2010 to avoid delays on that day.

HEALTH EXAMINATIONS

Physical examinations are required for students entering pre-kindergarten, early childhood, kindergarten, first graders entering the school system for the first time and sixth graders.

All children enrolling in kindergarten, and any child enrolling in an Illinois school for the first time, are required to have an eye examination before October 15, 2010.

Students in kindergarten, second, and sixth grade, and any child enrolling in District 124 for the first time, must have a dental exam prior to May 15, 2011.
